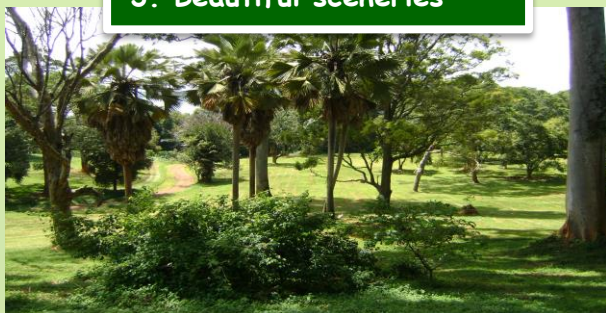




Visitors hold picnics, prayers and set up outdoor games in the spacious gardens.
